

# INTERNATIONAL CIVIC SERVICE IN VIENNE

Presentation of the host project

This document presents the City of Vienne's project to host in Vienne youngsters from the Twin Cities as part of an engagement mission of an international civic service, in 2019 – 2020.

Offered to youngsters from Esslingen, Piotrkow Trybunalski, Udine, Velenje, Goris and Albacete, this mobility project will bring a new dynamic to the partnerships.

Aims for the youngsters:

- Improve the foreign language practice
- Get out of their daily lives, discover a different environment, acquire new skills (independence, autonomy, empowerment, etc.)
- Gain an experience abroad, enrich by working with other youngsters, discover the true dimension of European citizenship
- Discover the City of Vienne and its actions, the interest for international mobility
- Bring a new dynamic of cooperation between partner cities
- Engage in a long-term volunteer mission of general interest
